2 Using Syndetics

2.1 Support and limitations

Syndetics can be used as cover image provider in Cicero's product suite: Mobile, Surf, Slide, LMS.

Syndetics provides images only for catalogues which use ISBN as an identifier for a bibliographic record (such as Cicero Catalogue). If an image is not found by the ISBN, Syndetics will return an icon image as fallback.

Cicero Mobile also supports Syndetics summary links in the Bibliographic record details, regardless of agency and catalogue, provided that the record comes with an ISBN.

2.2 Configuration in Cicero

When the configurations below are set, the change takes effect in all Cicero products showing cover images and bibliographic record links.

In Cicero Mobile

Go to Admin->General settings:

- In the configuration for cover image supplier, choose Syndetics
- In Syndetics Client ID, set the required ClientID

In Advanced settings:

- In "Links in bibliographic record", it is possible to add a new entry for Syndetics summary link

In Cicero LMS

Go to F7->Server settings.

- In the configuration for cover image supplier, choose Syndetics
- In Syndetics Client ID, set the required ClientID
- In links for bibliographic records, it is possible to add a new entry for Syndetics summary link (NOTE: This is easier to do in Mobile than in LMS)

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
