**Extraction of data for Innkrevningsetaten
(Oslo)**

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Interface Specification

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1 Introduction

This document describes the extraction and sending of balance data for Innkrevingsetaten in Oslo Kommun.

The data extraction is designed for use with Innkrevingsetaten in Oslo Kommun, but since the data is sent by email as csv files, it can potentially be sent to any third party.

The target group for this document is customers and users of Cicero LMS or relevant third party systems who are involved in the transfer of balance data.

2 Configurations

In Cicero LMS, the following configuration needs to be set up in the configuration for sending data to Innkrevingsetaten:

Configuration: "Afsendelse af mellemværende til Innkrevingsetaten (Norge)"

Fields:

- Enable automatic sending
- Email address for the recipient of the data
- Number of days before balances are sent

3 Extraction and Sending of Data

Once the configuration is enabled, the extraction job runs once a day (outside of normal work hours) and extracts two sets of balance data:

Exceeded balances: Balances that have exceeded their due date with the configured number of days, and are in state "Created".

Compensations with returned materials: Compensations that have been sent where the material has been returned, and the compensation is therefore cancelled.

In both extractions, a balance is only included once.

The data is extracted into two csv-files (see contents below) and sent to the email address specified. The email with the files is always sent, even if the files are empty.

4 Content of Data Extraction Files

The csv files with the balances contains the following data:

amount	Remaining amount on the balance	

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
